2019 Fees/Rules & Regulations

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO SELL WHAT PRODUCTS?

A vendor offering for sale articles for human consumption, such as fruits or their juices, vegetables, edible grains, nuts and berries, and apiary products or non-edible articles such as flowers, articles which have been raised or prepared or manufactured by the vendor. The Market Manager will approve regional/seasonal products other than those grown by the producer.

WHO ENFORCES THE MARKET RULES?

Occupants of spaces at this market must always conform to the market rules. The market manager has full authority to enforce all rules with the assistance from appropriate city departments.

WHAT ARE THE SELLING REGULATIONS?

All space holders selling or offering articles according to weight must be in accordance with established standards for weight in the State of Illinois. The source for all bulk products such as dried fruit, edible grains, dried herbs, nuts, and seeds must be identified and displayed. Any fruit juice except for cider, must be chilled. Dry ice is acceptable.

Product "dumping" below fair market value is prohibited except when the product is identified to purchaser as being inferior. All products must be sold at current market value or less.

No unwholesome or spoiled articles may be offered for sale such as cracked, or overripe produce, worm infested corn, etc.

Products labeled organically grown have not received chemically formulated pesticides or fertilizers. Certified organic growers must display certification.

A general listing of products and specialty items must be submitted to the market manager prior to market for his/her review. Market manager may individually determine whether certain items may be sold at the market.

All baked goods and on-site prepared food vendors must have acquired all necessary licenses, permits, etc. prior to market season and furnish copies to the market manager before selling products at the market.

The sale of meat, fish, eggs, and dairy products are permitted if the vendor is following all state laws and local health department rules and regulations covering such products sold at the market.

Only one Direct Sales of each company will be admitted.

WHAT ARE THE DISPLAY ARRANGEMENTS?

Products may be sold directly from vehicles in assigned area. Vendors must furnish their own tables, chairs, display arrangements and rain protection as the market will not supply them. No shelter is provided for vendors.

Each vendor must display a sign with name. Signage is also required for vendors accepting WIC/Senior coupons.

Delivery trucks and all other equipment used for transportation and display shall be kept clean always with adequate protection against contamination to products.

No smoking or vaping in vendor area.

CLEAN-UP REGULATIONS

Vendors must remove all waste and refuse from their spaces before leaving for the day. This refuse must be taken home. It would be useful to have a basket or bucket for trimmings and waste. Vendors' sales and display areas must be kept free and clear of unsightly and dangerous debris. Vendors who fail to clean up will face possible suspension or eviction from the market.
